

ESSER III Stakeholder Consultation

We would like to thank everyone who participated in the ESSER III Surveys and focus groups in May and June 2021. We had over 1500 responses from the community who completed the June online survey. Parents, teachers and district staff were notified of the ESSER survey through email. We had various focus groups consisting of the District Level Improvement Committee, Instructional Council, Principals, the Educational Operations Team, the Executive Leadership Team and the School Board. The results of the community mirrored the school and district staff results. The top ten most important needs identified for the district to address were: (1) technology, (2) extra cleaning of facilities, (3) tutors/interventionists, (4) social emotional health, (5) Special Education, (6) family engagement, (7) vaccination opportunities, (8) ESL support, (9) notification of close contacts at school/work and (10) Summer School. Ranking as the least important need to address was Saturday School. Public comment opportunities occurred during the Board meetings in June, July and August 2021.
