



Dear Parents/Guardians:

Your 6<sup>th</sup> grade student will soon be receiving information and choosing classes for 7<sup>th</sup> grade. Junior High counselors will be visiting with 6<sup>th</sup> graders from February 22nd – March 1st about the transition to junior high, the junior high experience, and to help students in choosing their classes for 7<sup>th</sup> grade. At that time, students will attend sessions based on the junior high where they are zoned, and receive information to help guide them in this process. Students who are applying for transfers will receive course request information from the new school, once accepted. Choosing courses for junior high is an important task. We encourage you to work with your student in helping them make the best decisions for their 7<sup>th</sup> grade year.
