

District Level Improvement
Committee Meeting Minutes

November 7, 2019

- I. Welcome at 4:30pm by Joe Harrington, who proceeded to introduce John Adkins – committee chairperson.
- II. Review of the Minutes from the May 16, 2019. Heather Thomas moved and Keri McCarty seconded to approve the Minutes. Passed.
- III. The HEB ISD construction updates -given by David Garcia. This data was regarding the Bond 2018 package, spending \$199 million on upgrades, updates and new buildings. All open projects are scheduled to be completed by August 2020. The CJH Orchestra project is complete. Euless Jr, Harwood Jr, Bedford Jr, Hurst Jr, and Central Jr renovations are in process. The two new elementary schools, Elem 21 off Precinct Line and Trinity and Elem 22 off International Drive and Midway, are proceeding nicely. Lastly, the West Hurst conversion has had a few things not expected surface but is coming along. Though funding came in under budget, David's group is reviewing other campuses as all Bond money can be spent on construction only.
- IV. The BCTEA Aerospace and Robotic Program was discussed by Derek Thorn and Michael Skrzynski along with 3 students. Each teacher gave a brief bio of themselves and then went into details about the program. It was stressed that the students research and build everything and the students explained how the program has taught them to seek the answers they need and not rely solely on the teacher.
- V. New Attendance Boundary Adjustments were brought to us by Joe Harrington. The new boundaries affect Elementary and Junior High students only. He told us there were approximately 1000 students overall affected by the changes.
